Washington, DC ... "Our Nation's Capital" ...the power city... is home to our Reunion this summer. No other city offers as many fun, free and cultural attractions to fill your days as this city! If you've never seen your Nation's fireworks come early, and celebrate "The Capital Fourth!" on The Mall.

Flying? There are 3 airports serving the DC area.

DCA - Reagan National (12 miles from hotel)
IAD - Washington Dulles International (20 miles from hotel)
BWI - Baltimore/Washington International (50 miles from hotel)

The Hotel, situated inside the Capital Beltway, can be reached via Metro (subway) from Reagan National should you wish to avoid a rental car. Two miles from the hotel is the "Dunn Loring" metro stop. Please coordinate your arrival in advance with the Hotel for shuttle pick up and for your return trip.

Driving? Parking on site is complimentary.

Our group rate is \$95 per night. When booking by phone, inform the front desk you are with the "Berlin Brats Alumni Association 2012 Reunion." Or visit our website at: www.BerlinBrats.org and click on the Hotel Reservation Link designed specifically for us by Marriott.

Check-in time is 4pm. Check-out time is 12 noon.

Our group rate is effective three (3) days before and three (3) days after the Reunion dates for those wishing to add on vacation time.

Our "room block" will be released to the general public on June 14, 2012 so bookings must be made prior to this date.

Your nightly rate of \$95 includes: 24 hr fitness center, complimentary parking on site, free shuttle to/from Dunn Loring Metro for arrival/departure and 2 complimentary round trip shuttle trips within a 3 mile radius of hotel for shopping or dining off site, coordinated with the Hotel's front desk. (day before the official start date)

The Oct 8th & 15th, 1961 TV shows showcase The Outpost Theatre, TAR (which was both the elementary and high school at the time) and our teen dances at the AYA. See if you recognize any Berlin Brat Reunion attendees in attendance at the school or dancing at the AYA. Performers Connie Frances, Syd Caesar, puppeteer Shari Lewis and Berlin teen heartthrob at the time Peter Kraus also appear. 30 minutes.

Bonus feature: Ollie North's "War Stories" segment on the "Standoff at Checkpoint Charlie."
Learn what actually transpired in Oct '61 just weeks after the Wall went up. Prepared specifically for the Berlin Brats, view this frightening moment in history which involved a Stuttgart grad's young father. 10 minutes.

Special feature: "Berlin Brats purchase a Section of the Berlin Wall"... then truck it across America." 20 minutes.
