Here are the champs!

Saturday, March 31, the boys Junior Division AYA All Star Basketball team won the USAREUR Championship held at Kaiserslautern by beating Fulda 38-35.

The Berlin team under the direction of Capt Charles Greene used a 3-1-1 full court zone press to make Fulda commit turnovers which the Berlin team turned into points. At the end of the first half the Berliners had a 22-18 lead.

The third quarter was a lackluster one for Berlin as they were held to a mere four points, but still had a 26-24 lead at the end of it.

The fourth quarter started with Fulda jumping out to an early 27-26 lead. Then Andre Camoron hit two free throws to put Berlin back on top. From there on Berlin was never seriously threatened until the final 49 seconds when Fulda's Kollkin scored two quick baskets to add some excitement, but Berlin squelched this rally to win 38-35.

Scoring for the Berlin Allstar team were as follows: Donnel 8, Brian 8, Curry 7, Turner 6, Cameron 5, and Jones 4. Kollkin led Fulda with 14 points.

The girls AYA basketball team lost a tight game to Frankfurt 13-12. Their game was also played in Kaiserslautern. Both teams used half court 2-3 zone presses to force most of the shooting to the outside. The game boiled down to a last second shot by Berlin which went in and out the rim. The girl/s still won second place in the USAREUR playoffs and are to be commended on their 16-3 record.

On Sunday, April 1, five girls from the Berlin AYA entered the German proof-riding test at Uncle Tom's Huette. Three of the girls won ribbons. Kathy Bailey won 4th place, Michelle Shacknow won 5th place, and Trena Rey won 6th place.

The AYA announce tryouts for the upcoming production of "Through the Looking Glass", April 16th and 17th at 5:30 hours at the TAR Gym on Huettenweg. As this will be the last play before the Summer Program the age limit will be 6-19. Everyone is urged to tryout.

Hopefully, the lessons you have learned on the basketball court about the need for teamwork and cooperation will serve you well throughout life. Keep up the good work!

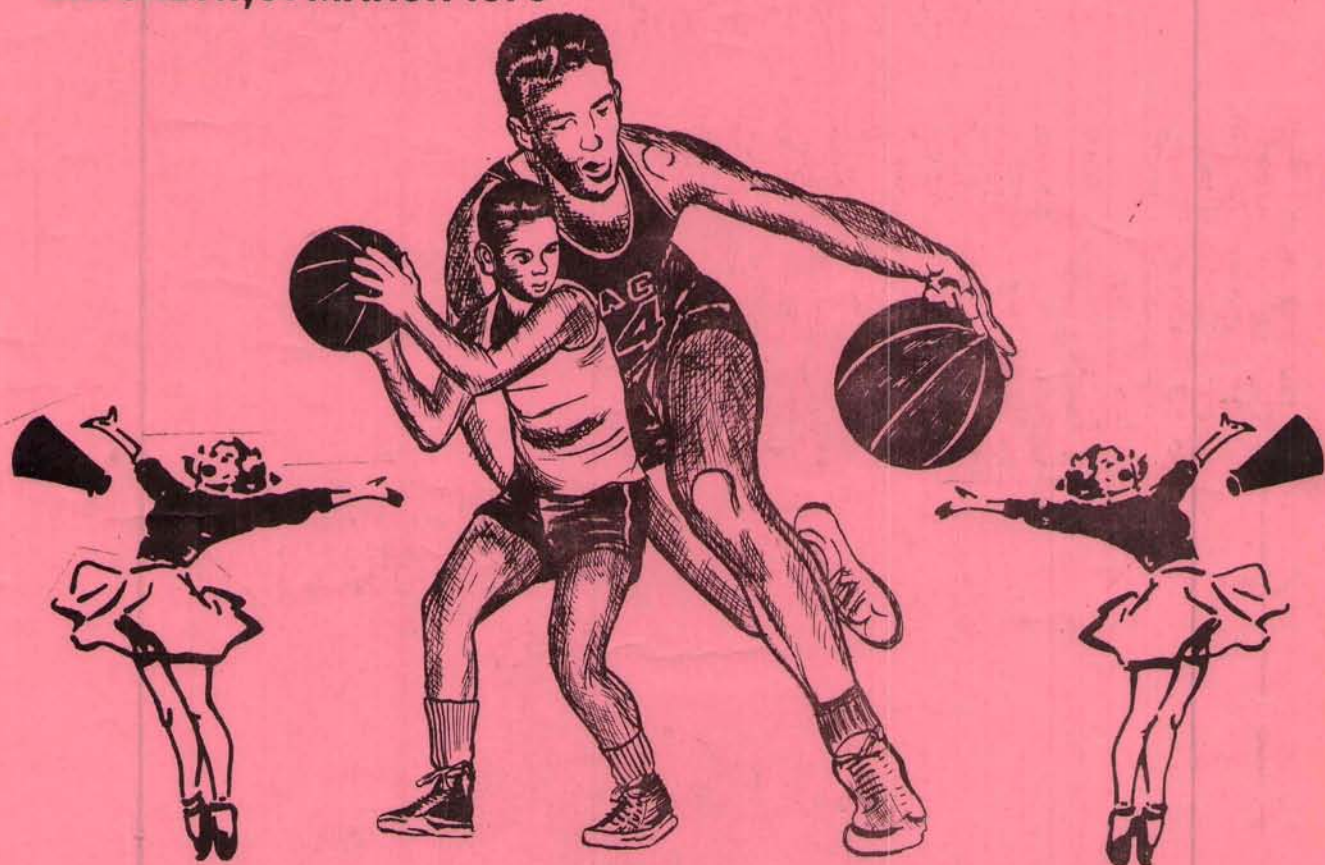
