1 ANNCR: (COLD) Hey, gang! It's your Teen Canteen on the Air!

2 MUSIC: OPENING THEME IN FULL, THEN TO BG FOR

3 ANNCR: That's right, gang! This is your Teen Canteen on the
4 Air! Fifteen minutes in which you'll be hearing from
5 teen-agers in Berlin...the top songs of the week, as
6 chosen by you, at TAR High School. Yes, all this,
7 plus a few surprises are yours now, as the Teen Canteen
8 is on the air!

9 MUSIC: UP FULL, THEN TO BUT UNDER

10 ANNCR: And now, here's your Teen-age mistress of ceremonies...

11 ANN: [REDACTED] Ann Worrell!

12 ANN: Thanks, Jimmy...and hi there, gang.

13 ANNCR: Hold...hol it, Ann! This morning, we're going to do
14 something different!

15 ANN: [REDACTED] What's that?

16 ANNCR: Well, for weeks now, we've been introducing you, then
17 leaving it up to Skippy to fit herself into the script.

18 ANN: [REDACTED] ...And....?????

19 ANNCR: ...And this morning, we're going to change things
20 around by giving Skippy the All-out treatment...fanfares
21 and all!

22 SKIP: Do you think I can stand it?

23 ANN: [REDACTED] Quiet, Skippy...you're not on yet.

24 SKIP: Oh.

25 ANNCR: Ready, Clint? Okay, then...and now, here she is...
26 that ever-popular, ever-welcome member of your Teen

1 ANNCR: (CONT'D) Canteen show... she's lovely! She's
2 free! And she uses Drsno??? Oh, well...here's
3 Skippy Babbitt.

4 MUSIC: COMEDY FAN IN FULL

5 SKIPP Thank you....I think.

6 ANN: Well, what's up this morning, Skippy? This is your
7 show this morning.

8 SKIP: Well, I think I'll go home, then.

9 ANNCR: Hold on there, Skippy. We've got to put something on
10 that the kids will like!

11 SKIP: Well, we can't do it...that's all there is to it!

12 ANN: And why not?

13 SKIP: 'Cause I heard some of the kids say that they'd like
14 to hear a real American-type soap opera ...complete
15 with commercials.

16 ANNCR: Well, what's wrong with that?

17 SKIP: Well, for one thing...we can't have any commercials
18 on AFN.

19 ANNCR: Oh, but we can!

20 SKIP: But what about a soap opera?

21 ANNCR: I think I've got the ~~sassack~~ to that one, too. You
22 kids go ahead with the show... (FADING OFF) I'll
23 be right back!

24 ANN: Well, I guess we might as well hear some music, huh,
25 Skippy?

26 SKIP: Okay with me, Ann. How 'bout that new song we were

2 on the air?

3 ANN: Fine. (UP SLIGHTLY) And here it is, kids...a song that
4 we think will go right to the top of the hit parade....

5 WACKIN' - BY JANE HUTTON

6 MUSIC: WACKIN'

7 ANNCR: You kids making out all right?

8 SKIP: Fine. How 'bout you?

9 ANNCR: Yep. I've got that soap opera all whipped together
10 for you...and it's kind of special!

11 ANN: How do you mean, Jimmy?

12 ANNCR: Well, in Germany, here, I haven't heard a real stateside
13 soap opera yet...and I don't think many of the Germans
14 have, either. They have their own version of them,
15 but not a real one...as we know them.

16 SKIP: What are you getting at?

17 ANNCR: Well, we dug up this one...all in German. That is,
18 except for just a few little words that couldn't be
19 translated. So we had to leave them in English. But
20 it's not too bad.

21 SKIP: What does it sound like?

22 ANNCR: Well, something like this....

23 BIZ: MORGEN SOAP OPERA IN FULL TO END

24 ANN: Hey! We're just about out of time again!

25 ANNCR: Sure looks that way, Ann. Well, it's up to you now,
26 Skippy.

1 SKIP: Okay. So long until next week, kids!

2 MUSIC: CLOSING THEME IN FULL, THEN TO BG FOR

3 ANN: Well, that's it for another week, kids. Hope you've
4 enjoyed the show this morning. We'd like to give
5 credit where it's due...mainly to Henry Morgan and
6 the cast for the soap opera take-off on this morning's
7 show....to our producer, Corporal Clint Ramey...and to
8 all of you for being with us. Hope you can make it
9 again next Saturday morning, when once again, the
10 Teen Canteen is on the Air!
